BUSINESS CONTINUITY DISCLOSURE

Beech Hill Securities, Inc. has developed a Business Continuity Plan to prepare for events that may significantly disrupt its business operations. As the nature, timing and impact of disruptions are unpredictable, we work with flexibility toward responding to actual events as they occur. Keeping that in mind, please consider the following select aspects of our business continuity plan.

The Personal Information That We Collect And Communicate

If after a significant business disruption, you cannot contact us as you usually do at (212) 350-7200, you should call our alternative number (800) 413-3635. If you cannot access information from us through either of those means, you should contact our clearing firm, Pershing LLC at (201) 413-3635 for information on how they may assist with trading or other account-related services in the context of a significant business disruption.

Our Business Continuity Plan

We plan to quickly recover and resume business operations after a significant business disruption and respond by safeguarding our employees and property, making financial and operational assessments, protecting the firm's books and records, and allowing our customers to transact business. In short, our business continuity plan is designed to permit our firm to resume operations as quickly as possible, given the scope and severity of the significant business disruption.

Our business continuity plan addresses: data backup and recovery; mission critical systems; financial and operational assessments; alternative communications with customers, employees, and regulators; alternate work location of employees; critical business constituent impact; regulatory reporting; and assuring our customers prompt access to their funds and securities if we are unable to continue our business.

Our clearing firm, Pershing LLC, handles many aspects of our trading activities and backs up certain aspects of our important records. While every emergency situation poses unique problems based on external factors, we have been advised by our clearing firm that its objective is to restore its own operations and be able to complete existing transactions and accept new transactions and payments in accordance with its business continuity plan objectives. Varying Disruptions

Significant business disruptions can vary in their scope, such as only our firm, a single building housing our firm, the business district where our firm is located, the city where we are located, or the whole region. Within each of these areas, the severity of the disruption can also vary from minimal to severe. In a disruption to only our firm or a building housing our firm, we will transfer operations locations as needed and expect to recover and resume business within two business days. In a disruption affecting our business district, city, or region, we will seek to transfer our operations outside of the affected area and recover and resume business within three business days. In either situation, we plan to continue in business, transfer operations to our clearing firm if necessary, and notify you through our website or via telephone how to contact us. If the significant business disruption is so severe that it prevents us from remaining in business, we will assure our customer's prompt access to their funds and securities.
